The College is requested to note

- A.** From 2011-12, for all sanctions, the sanctioned amount is divided into three heads in proportion of 77.5% for General, 16% for SC and 7.5% for ST.
- B.** No photocopy of documents or the originals and detailed list of purchases should be sent with the accounts submitted unless specifically called for.

- The sanctioned amount is debitable to the major head: I.B-C(H) and valid for payment during the current financial year only.
- The sanction of the grant shall be drawn by the Accounts Officer (Drawing and Disbursing Officer), University Grants Commission on the Grant-in-Aid bill and shall be disbursed to and credited to grantee as above through Demand Draft.
- The grant is subject to the adjustment on the basis of Utilisation Certificate in the prescribed proforma submitted by the University/College/Institution.
- The University/College shall maintain proper accounts of the expenditure out of the grant which shall be utilised only on approved heads of expenditure.
- The Utilisation Certificate to the effect that the grant has been utilised for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned shall be furnished to the University Grants Commission as early as possible after the closing of the current financial year.
- The assets acquired wholly or substantially out of the University Grants Commission's grant shall not be disposed of or encumbered or utilized for the purpose other than those for which the grant was given, without proper sanction of the University Grants Commission.
- A register of assets acquired, wholly or substantially out of the grant shall be maintained by the University/College in the prescribed form.
- The grantee institution shall ensure the utilization of grant-in-aid for which it is being sanctioned/paid. In case of non-utilization of grant, the simple interest @ 10% per annum as amended from time to time on unutilized amount from the date of drawal to the date of refund as per provisions contained in General Financial Rules of Govt. of India will be charged.
- The University/College shall follow strictly all the instructions issued by the Government of India from time to time with regard to reservation of posts for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes.
- The University/College shall strictly implement the Official Language Policy of the Union Govt. and comply with the Official Language Act, 1953 and Official Language (used for official purposes of the Union) Rules, 1979 etc.
- The sanction issued in exercise of the delegation of powers of the Commission Office Order No. 25802 dated May 01, 1982 has been utilized by the College for the purpose for which it was sanctioned and noted in the Grant-in-Aid Register.
